DEVICE DESCRIPTION:

Latex Exam Gloves – Powdered.

A disposable device made of natural latex intended for medical purposes that is worn on the examiner's hand or finger to prevent contamination between patient and examiner. Non-sterile medical examination gloves, which may or may not be anatomically shaped. These gloves are powdered. Examination gloves are intended for conducting medical examinations, diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and for handling contaminated medical material.

INTENDED USER:

Healthcare professionals.

TARGET PATIENT POPULATION:

These examination gloves are used for all patient population for examination procedures only.

DEVICE SHELF LIFE:

5 years from the date of manufacture printed on the product label

STORAGE INSTRUCTION:

It is recommended to store the gloves in cool, dry place, in the temperature range of 10°C to 30°C and to protect them against direct sunlight.

INDICATIONS:

- Protection of the wearer from contamination with blood, secretions, and excretions and the associated risk of contamination with pathogens capable of reproduction.
- Prevention of pathogen release from the hand into the exam site.
- Defined pathogen barrier as protection from biological agents.

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS:

- 1. Do not use after the expiry date printed on the label.
- 2. Do not use if the Package is opened or damaged. Use of product whose package is opened, or damage may cause inflammation.
- 3. Do not Re Use. The reuse of the gloves may cause severe complications such as cross contamination, dermatitis, loss of physical properties, infection, allergic reaction and poor barrier protection.
- 4. Latex gloves are made of Natural rubber latex, which may cause allergic reactions including Latex Allergy Anaphylactic if the user is allergic to latex.
- 5. Gloves may contain excess powder residues which may cause respiratory tract disease.
- 6. Single Use mentioned on Sales Packaging Label.
- 7. Device should not be stored in direct sunlight
- 8. Device disposable should be done as per local regulatory norms.

CONTRA INDICATIONS:

- 1. Gloves contain Powder content, persons who are sensitive to powder may develop allergy towards the powder content
- 2. Latex gloves are made of Natural rubber latex, which may cause allergic reactions including Latex Allergy Anaphylactic if the user is allergic to latex.

DIRECTION FOR USE:

- Select the appropriate size Gloves for the hand.
- Take out the Gloves from the pouch by peeling it off at the site of direction for open.
- Wear the gloves Left hand & Right Hand.
- Must check the date of manufacturing and expiry date before use.
- Adjust the gloves as needed.

A) How to Don Gloves:

- Rubbing the hand with alcohol or wash with water

Latex Examination Gloves-Powdered

- Dry hands before donning the gloves.
- Take out gloves from single unit packaging.
- Gloves need to be donned carefully; do not apply excessive force to pull the gloves when donning.
- Keep the fingernails short and change gloves frequently to avoid tearing issue.

B) How to Remove Gloves:

- The gloves should be discarded with an appropriate waste disposal container after use according to local disposal regulations

DURATION OF USE:

Duration of Use is transient (Less than 60 minutes)
